



## PUBLIC NOTICE: PENTWATER DREDGING



**PLEASE BE ADVISED:** Dredging at Pentwater Harbor will start on 9<sup>th</sup> June 2026 and is expected to conclude at the end of June. These operations are essential to maintain safe navigational depths within the harbor and support ongoing marine traffic and port activities.

### Details of Operations:

- **Dredging Area:** the harbor entrance in Lake Michigan and between the breakwater heads
- **Discharge Location:** Dredged material will be transported through submerged pipeline and discharged near shore starting roughly 800ft south of the breakwater and continuing south in 4ft to 8ft of water, which can vary greatly in distance from shore.
- **Dredged Material:** Multiple samples of the dredge material have been taken to confirm contents and suitability for beach nourishment.

### Safety and Navigation Advisory:

- Submerged pipeline will be marked with orange buoys every 500ft and a bright yellow, lit pontoon at each end. Depending on time of day, pontoons can vary in appearance.



- Navigate with caution near dredging equipment (pictured at top) and follow all posted maritime signals and temporary navigation aids.
